

King's University College Students' Council presents *Canadian Musical Icons: Stars & Bedouin Soundclash*

The King's University College Students' Council is proud to welcome concert artists, Stars and Bedouin Soundclash for a concert to be held on October 20 at London Music Hall.

Stars first hit the Canadian music scene in 2001 with their debut album *Nightsongs* and has since released six full length studio albums receiving high critical acclaim followed by multiple Juno, Polaris Music Prizes and MMVA nominations. Stars' music has been described as "beautiful, eloquent indie pop", characterized by lush instrumentation, nimble production and mixing, narrative lyrics, and soft but nuanced vocals. Their songs have been featured on such television programs as *The O.C.*, *Degrassi*, *Gossip Girl* and *the Vampire Diaries*. Their most recent album, *The Five Ghosts* includes such hits as "Changes" and "Dead Hearts".

Bedouin Soundclash first turned heads with their 2005 breakout debut of "The Night Feels My Song" taking home a Juno Award for Single of the Year. Since then, singles such as "Walls Fall Down" and more recently, "Mountain Top" have also taken home awards and torn up the Canadian and International music charts. Their sound has been described as a combination of modern urban sounds with classic reggae fundamentals.

"We are very excited to host such critically acclaimed Canadian artists for our concert," President Barshan Quadry stated when discussing the upcoming event. "We wanted to mix it up and provide something fresh and different from the typical DJ event we have provided in the past."

This year's concert is going to be held downtown at London Music Hall on Thursday, October 20th.
