

KUCSC Declaration of Campaign Team and Affiliated Parties

“Affiliated party” An affiliated party is someone or a group connected to a candidate, helping out with their campaign. It includes individuals, groups, or corporations that the candidate either knew or should have reasonably known would assist in their campaign.

“Independent party” An independent party is someone or a group not directly associated with the candidate. They are not considered affiliated with the candidate's campaign.

There can be a maximum of ten (10) members for each campaign team (excluding the candidate themselves) that will be considered non-arm’s-length parties.

Failure to submit this form to the Governance Officer by the conclusion of the All Candidates Meeting could result in the issuing of demerit points by the Governance Associate and the General Manager per the Election Policy.

Candidates shall be responsible for the actions, and violations stemming from such actions, of any affiliated party unless the Candidate satisfies the Governance Associate that he or she did not direct the action, and could not have reasonably foreseen that the action would occur. Candidates may dissociate themselves from any person or organization who would otherwise be considered an affiliated party, provided that they give immediate notice to the Governance Associate, in writing, and provided the Committee is satisfied that the dissociation is genuine.
